Rules Governing Operation of Raffle

1. Age limit for ticket purchasers is 18 years or older and the name of a person under the age of 18 may not be written on the ticket due to requirements of the Public Trustee Act.
2. All sets of multiple tickets must contain the same information
3. Tickets will not be sold outside of the province of Alberta.
4. The number of tickets printed in this lottery is 4,250 structured as: 250 @ \$25 each, 750 @\$50 for 3 tickets, 1,250@\$75 for 5 tickets, 2,000@\$100 dollars for 8 tickets.
5. Tickets may be purchased with cheque, VISA, MasterCard, bank debit card, and cash. The Lottery Committee's liability is limited to the purchase price of the ticket.
6. Ticket control and distribution **For the Love of Animals Lottery** will be under the management of Central Alberta Humane Society, 4405-77 Street, Red Deer, AB, T4P 2J1.
7. All draw(s) will be managed by Central Alberta Humane Society, 4505-77 Street, Red Deer, AB, T4P2J1
The draw details are as follows:

Main Draw for all prizes;
1st Prize - 50/50 Prize (Minimum guaranteed \$12,500 or 50% of ticket sales, whichever is greater)
2nd Prize - \$1000 Cash
3rd Prize - \$500 Cash
Ticket sales cut-off: January 31st, 2018 (12:00 noon)
Draw date: Feb 5th, 2018 (at 12:00 noon)
at Central Alberta Humane Society, 4505-77 Street, Red Deer, AB, T4P2J1
8. Any person wishing to view the draws may do so by attending the above location(s) on the draw date(s).
9. Ticket sales cut-off dates provide for cheques to clear the bank prior to a ticket being issued and placed in the draw drum.
10. The following are ineligible to purchase tickets in the lottery:
 - o All Central Alberta Humane Society Board members and Staff and anyone living with them
11. Only upon demonstrating extraordinary circumstances to Alberta Gaming & Liquor Commission will the Licensee make a request for a draw date extension.
12. In the event that all tickets have been sold when a ticket request form is received from a potential ticket purchaser, the potential purchaser will be notified and where applicable a refund of the ticket purchase amount will be made.

13. Anyone wishing to cancel his or her ticket purchase and receive a full refund may do so, providing that the request is in writing and is received one week prior to the draw. Requests for ticket cancellation must be mailed or hand delivered to Central Alberta Humane Society, 4505 77 Street, Red Deer AB T4P 2J1. If any purchased ticket has been entered into the drum for any draw, no refund will be issued (as that ticket will be deemed to have received its fair market value).
14. Ticket purchases are NOT eligible for tax receipts under Revenue Canada rules.
15. Prizes must be accepted as awarded – no prize or cash substitutions will be offered unless otherwise stated in these official rules or unless the prize offers an advertised cash option.
16. All winners have one year from the date of the draw to claim their prize. If any prize remains unclaimed for 1 day more than one year from the draw date, a request will be made to Alberta Gaming & Liquor Commission for a decision regarding the disbursement of the prize(s).
17. Prizes will be awarded as outlined in a letter from The Central Alberta Humane Society and will be awarded as presented, where presented. Expenses incurred by the winner to claim their prize will not be reimbursed (for example, travel to pick-up prize or postage to provide special delivery of prize).
18. Prizes will be drawn in the following order:
 - 1. 3rd (Third) Place
 - 2. 2nd (Second)Place
 - 3. 1st (First) Place
19. Once drawn, a winning ticket will be eligible to win any other prize and will be returned to the draw barrel.
20. Tickets may be purchased by more than one person and space is provided for on the back of tickets to cover these orders. However, if a ticket stub with more than one purchaser is drawn, the licensee shall award the prize to any individual(s) whose name is listed first on the official stub. The licensee and Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission are not responsible for any disputes, which may arise between different persons purchasing one ticket.
21. All winners will be notified in writing and in some cases also by telephone, by Central Alberta Humane Society Officials informing them of what they have won and how to claim the prize. All winners' names will be published on the charities website: www.cahumane.com.
22. The Central Alberta Humane Society reserves the right to publish the name(s) and photographs of all winners, for promotional and notification reasons; unless notified in writing by the individual winner upon notification of their winning and prior to publication dates of their wish to remain anonymous.
