Volunteer Role Description

Would you rather talk to cats than to people? Then this job is for you! Our cats need loving interaction with people. Cat Cuddling volunteers provide essential playtime, brushing, TLC, social interaction, and love for our shelter cats to keep them happy and healthy during their stay. Become a Cat Volunteer and you'll be the Cat's Meow!

Prerequisites/Necessary Skills:

1. Must be a minimum of 16 years of age.
2. Complete the Volunteer Orientation and Cat Cuddling training.
3. Comfortable with cats of all sizes and temperaments.
4. A genuine love of cats and a concern for the welfare of animals that is consistent with the philosophies of Red Deer & District SPCA.
5. Due to limited resources, volunteers must be able to complete all job requirements with minimal assistance from SPCA staff.

Duties:

- Sign in and out before and after each shift
- Record all hours in the Volunteer Binder
- Spend time petting, brushing and playing with the cats in one of our free roam cat communities
- Strictly adhere to all animal handling and safety protocols as outlined by RDSPCA

Time commitment: Minimum 3 month commitment

Frequency of commitment: Weekly (same day and time each week)

Session length: Minimum of 1 hour

Accessibility: 9AM - 5PM Monday through Sunday, excluding Stat Holidays
