Volunteer Role Description

Rub a dub, dub, pets in the tub! We are looking for volunteers interested in bathing and brushing our pets in preparation for adoption. Being shiny clean and brushed nicely helps the dogs and cats put their best paws forward and increases their chances on getting a new home.

Prerequisites/necessary skills:

1. Must be a minimum of 18 years of age.
2. Complete the Volunteer Orientation
3. Comfortable with animals of all sizes, breeds, and temperaments
4. A genuine love of all animals and a concern for the welfare of animals that is consistent with the philosophies of the RDSPCA
5. Due to limited resources, volunteers must be able to complete all job requirements with minimal assistance from RDSPCA staff.

Duties:

- Sign in and out before and after each shift
- Record all hours in the Volunteer Binder
- Bathe and brush animals on the grooming list
- Follow cleaning protocols (as specified by RDSPCA) and adhere to safety animal handling guidelines at all times
- Communicate in through the communication log

Commitment: Minimum of 3 months of weekly sessions

Frequency of sessions: Weekly

Session length: Minimum of 2 hours

Accessibility: 9AM-5PM Monday - Sunday
