### Volunteer Role Description

#### **Prerequisites/Necessary Skills:**

1. Minimum of 18 years of age
2. Professional in demeanour with excellent customer service skills
3. Excited about working with the public
4. Wonderful smile and willingness to help where ever you are needed
5. Ability to work with confidential information and understanding the importance of maintaining confidentiality
6. Be energetic and have strong interpersonal skills
7. A genuine love of animals and a concern for the welfare of animals that is consistent with the philosophies of the RDSPCA

#### **Duties:**

- Sign in and out before and after each shift
- Keep Disaster Team Information Folder up to date and accessible at all times
- Call to mobilize other disaster team volunteers when instructed to do so by RDDSPCA Disaster Team Coordinator
- Assist RDDSPCA in responding to local disaster incidents to assist in the provision of local emergency disaster services for animals
- Load, organize and distribute supplies required for the relief operation as needed

**Time commitment:** Flexible

**Frequency of commitment:** On-call

**Session length:** Variable, depending on event
