Volunteer Role Description

We all know how much laundry can pile up at home with a busy family. Now imagine how much you would have if your family had hundreds of members! With hundreds of guest pets living in our facility everyday the laundry can really pile up. That is why volunteers willing to help us out with laundry are always needed to ensure that our guest pets get comfy clean bedding and receive the best care possible.

Prerequisites/necessary skills:

1. Must be a minimum of 16 years of age.
2. Attend an orientation/training session.
3. Must be comfortable handling soiled and smelly laundry.
4. Due to limited resources, volunteers must be able to complete all job requirements with minimal assistance from RDSPCA staff.

Duties:

- Sign in and out before and after each shift
- Record all hours in the Volunteer Binder
- Machine wash, dry, fold and put away laundry
- Keep laundry room clean and organised
- Use proper equipment (as specified by RDSPCA) and adhere to safety precautions and cleaning protocols at all times

Commitment: Minimum of 3 months of weekly sessions

Frequency of sessions: Weekly

Session length: Minimum of 2 hours

Accessibility: 9am to 6pm Monday to Sunday
