Volunteer Role Description

Pawsitively gorgeous! We are looking for licensed and experienced certified pet groomers willing to volunteer some time on behalf of our furry friends in preparation for adoption. It's hard to feel good when it's time for a clip and trim, and we want our guest pets to be in good hands to help them look and feel their best.

Prerequisites/necessary skills:

1. Must be a minimum of 18 years of age.
2. **Must have certification and experience as a licensed groomer.**
3. Complete the Volunteer Orientation.
4. Comfortable with dogs of all sizes, breeds, and temperaments.
5. A genuine love of all animals and a concern for the welfare of animals that is consistent with the philosophies of the RDSPCA.
6. Due to limited resources, volunteers must be able to complete all job requirements with minimal assistance from RDSPCA staff.

Duties:

- Sign in and out before and after each shift
- Record all hours in the Volunteer Binder
- Bathe and brush animals on the grooming list
- Perform other grooming techniques (ie. shaving, nail clipping, etc.) at the request of the Animal Care Manager
- Follow cleaning protocols (as specified by RDSPCA) and adhere to safety animal handling guidelines at all times
- Communicate in through the communication log

Commitment: Minimum of 3 months of weekly sessions

Frequency of sessions: Weekly

Session length: Minimum of 2 hours

Accessibility: 9AM-5PM Monday - Sunday
